Several hundreds of Ghanaian children are denied of basic healthcare needs because parents, guardians and other caregivers who are supposed to provide them with such life necessities are simply not there for them due to one reason or the other.

It is really disheartening to see children as young as two (2)-year-olds who have been rendered orphaned due to drowning of their parents. A number of them have also dropped out of school as a result. These came to light, during a working visit to Bruben, a fishing community within the Afram Plains municipality of the Eastern Region on July 16, 2025.





Crystal News interacted with some community members who indicated that those who fall within the dropout category needed just pairs of shoes, bags and uniforms to be enrolled back in school.

The above information is meant to draw the attention of people in authority about the need to give children, who represent the future of the country the best they deserve as far as their health and general wellbeing is concerned. Crystal News believes that every child deserves not just a healthy future, but one that is full of hope.

As we focus on child health in this month of August, parents, guardians and other caregivers are being reminded to give children the healthy start they deserve. Ghana in May this year joined the rest of the Continent to formally launch the 2025 African Vaccination Week (AVW) with a renewed commitment to strengthening child health services and expanding immunization coverage across the country. The theme for the year, 'Healthy Beginnings, hopeful futures', sought to among other things, sensitize parents and guardians on the importance of making their children available for vaccination and offering them the needed care they deserve.

The Child health Promotion Week which further emphasized the fact that, every child deserves the chance to grow up healthy and strong, offered free essential services such as immunizations, Vitamin A administration, birth registration, growth checks and malaria prevention tips among others.

Crystal News is happy to learn that during the period, the Ghana Health Service through the Ministry of Health in partnership with its development partners used the occasion to introduce two (2) new vaccines in addition to the existing ones as part of the country's life-course immunization strategy. The new vaccines are the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine for adolescent girls and the Hepatitis B birth dose for newborns.

Childbearing parents are reminded that exclusive breastfeeding, immunization and timely care during illness all contribute to the child's healthy growth and development. Moreover, providing clean air, water and sanitation as well as ensuring safe places for play and recreation are likewise, important for young children to explore and learn.

The nationwide exercise is expected to roll out in September this year
As part of preparations towards the exercise, key pharmaceutical companies have been urged to produce some of the vaccines locally.

- **Malaria**
- Tuberculosis
- Whooping Cough
- Acute lower respiratory infections
- **Measles**
- Diphtheria

Here in Ghana, the six deadly infectious diseases; Pneumonia, Tuberculosis, Diarrhoeal diseases, Malaria, Measles and more recently HIV/AIDS are said to account for half of all premature deaths, thus, killing mostly children and young adults.
